# About Us

One Hundred Angels was established in 2018 with a goal to bring comfort and dignity to rural communities in need. This journey started with a medical mission to El Salvador and we have now completed 17 international missions, along with six ongoing missions, serving six countries, and impacting over 45,000 people in the last four years. OHA seeks to support missions that are already at work in this field, as well as to carry out new missions that will promote comfort and wellbeing to communities that are underserved. Whether it's an ongoing mission that we serve daily, an international mission that's coordinated monthly or annually, or emergent action needed due to a crisis, we seek to leave a better world than what we have found.



This past year, One Hundred Angels had the privilege and honor to serve the communities of Berlin, El Salvador and outlying cantones which is a total of approximately 35,000 people. We have provided 150 water collection tanks, impacting over 600 people, which are necessary for these communities as they live in a volcanic region and their water is contaminated by sulfur.

We are committed to behaving with compassion and understanding, which enables us to make connections and build bridges between communities in need and with those who are willing to offer support.


## **LOVE:**




# 2022 Summary

One Hundred Angels facilitated a great amount of internal and administrative change in 2022, which has accelerated our growth and evolution as an organization. From an increase in staff to a new board of directors, new partnership opportunities, and even a new website-- 2022 was pivotal for OHA.

- 18,676 hygiene kits provided
- 10 shelters supported
- 75 water collection tanks provided
- 100 medical treatments facilitated
- 5 new OHA board members
- 7 costumes provided to Dejando Huellas in Uruguay
- Our CEO became a Board Member for Dejando Huellas
- \$4,200 spent on student's tuition
- 5 international children's celebrations facilitated
- 4137 children helped in 4 countries
- 3 international missions
- 13 grants submitted for and 10 awarded
- One month's worth of food provided to Pancitas Llenas in Uruguay to feed 100 children daily in August
- Contributed \$250 a month to Huellas ONG to support the feeding and care for dogs in a shelter in Uruguay
- New website created in Spanish and English
- OHA is participating in the Maricopa Country Advisory Board
- 11 volunteer events held
- 600 children impacted by celebrations in Uruguay
- Created a new handbook for employees and volunteers, new governing documents, and upgraded our administrative capacity using Trello and Google Workspace
- New partnership with medical group in Mexico via Rancho Feliz collaboration

# Asylum Seeker Mission



2022 has been busier than ever for the One Hundred Angels Asylum Seeker Mission. With the support of the community, our major donors, and partners in the sector, we have been able to do more than we ever have. This year, we re-instated our Phoenix Mission, which provides aid to the asylum-seeking community entering Maricopa County, Arizona. Currently, we are the only organization providing backpacks and hygiene kits, over-the-counter medication, along with information for medical assistance through the Federally Qualified Health-

care Clinics in their destination city. We provide this service to ten different shelters between Maricopa County and the Mexican border. We are currently packing and delivering approximately two thousand hygiene kits per month, which started in March of 2022. We have also provided medication stations to each shelter so that they can provide basic medical aid to these families in emergent situations. In 2022, we provided 18,676 hygiene kits between March and December to the asylum-seeking population.

# Water Tank Mission



One Hundred Angels has been providing water collection tanks to communities in El Salvador and it has become one of our primary missions to support these families. In 2022, we provided 75 water collection tanks, and have contributed a total of 150 water collection tanks in the last three years.



Because these families live in a volcanic region, their water supply has been contaminated with sulfur. With these water tanks the families can store the water they collect from the rain during the rainy season, as well as store this valuable and essential resource when they get it from the creek or the well.



One Hundred Angels visited these communities in December of 2022 to ensure the water tanks had been delivered and to coordinate the 2023 plan to continue to meet the needs of these families with additional water tanks. We have impacted 600 people in the region.



# Childrens Mission


In 2022, One Hundred Angels hosted two missions in El Salvador and Uruguay. We also provided a partner organization Pancitas Llenas a month's worth of food for 100 children in Uruguay in addition to 25 kilos of milk, 25 kilos of sugar, and 25 kilos of cocoa. We have recently partnered with Dejando Huellas from Uruguay and supplied seven costumes to help this organization provide comfort and celebrations to children. Our Founder and CEO has joined the board of directors for that organization.

One Hundred Angels provides support to children in Central, South, and North America on several levels. We are currently providing tuition for a boy in Mexico, which includes transportation, books, and therapies.

We started these missions in 2019 and have hosted a total of eight Christmas missions, four in El Salvador, three in Uruguay, and one in Mexico. In addition, we have hosted one Halloween mission, a Graduation Celebration, along with other celebrations in the countries, impacting approximately 1,600 children since we started these missions.



# A Global Review



We provided aid to a total of 19,876 people. While the Asylum Seeker Mission impacted the largest amount of people, we were also able to provide water collection tanks to communities in El Salvador which improved the lives of 600 people. Additionally, we provided food, drink, toys, and celebrations to 600 children in Uruguay.

In 2022, One Hundred Angels provided 9,514 units of medication to our partners. We have provided shelters with 5,464 units of medical supplies. OHA also partnered with an organization in Mexico called Rancho Feliz where we have established a shared desire to bring medical care and supplies to Agua Prieta, Mexico. We have sent 4,050 units of over-the-counter medical supplies and visited their location in 2022. We are currently planning to be a part of a Medical Mission to Agua Prieta in May of 2023.



# Work with Us
